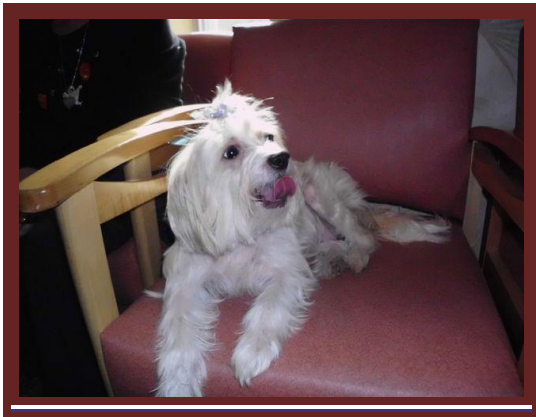


Brady

Brady's special treat every night is vanilla yoghurt. His owner is Betsy Anderson.

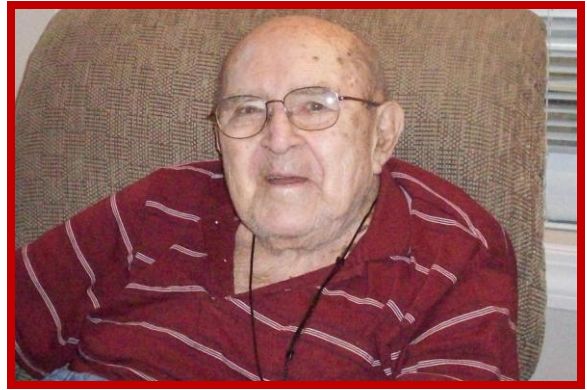


Katie

When asked about Heritage, he said that he liked the people. He states that Bob Schilling, one of Heritage's wait staff, is his "best friend".

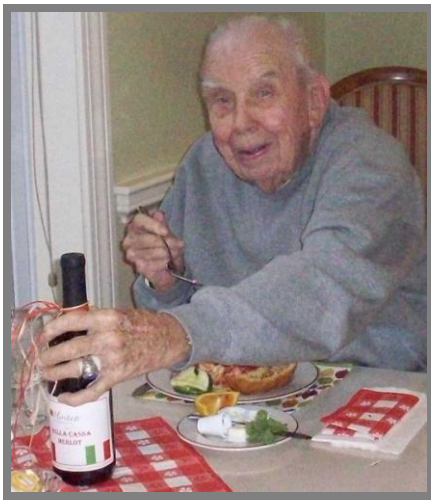
It was a great pleasure interviewing Jeff. He is a very friendly and interesting man to talk to.

The residents were treated to Hemenway School's kindergarten class, who were all in costume for the occasion. There was also a Halloween lunch in the Peloquin Room.



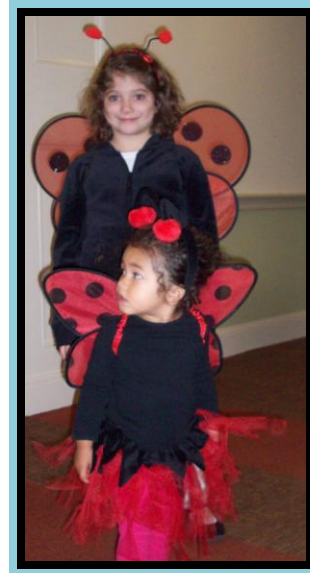
